#### **PARADE RULES/REGULATIONS:**

- Parade entries may only complete one lap of parade route. 1.
- 2. Riding on top of or outside of vehicles without belts or harnesses is prohibited.
- Fire or any open flame on any entrant is prohibited. 3.
- All drivers of vehicles and floats shall possess a valid driver's license. 4.
- Fire extinguishers rated 2A-10BC are required on all motorized decorated vehicles. 5.
- Exhaust systems shall extend beyond all decorations so that drivers or riders are not exposed to carbon monoxide fumes. 6.
- 7. Compressed gases (such as helium) should be properly secured and safeguarded.
- 8 All participants should maintain twenty-five (25) feet distance between one another to allow visibility of children and other participants potentially running into the street.
- 9 All decorative materials must be fire retardant.
- 10. Parade entrants unsafely operating vehicles or animals will be removed from parade and cited by the Othello Police Department.
- 11. The City of Othello reserves the right to bar from the parade at any time any entrant not conforming to the rules or refusing to
- follow the instructions of the police or parade officials.
- 12. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited on any float or vehicle or on the person of any participant.
- 13. Candy is not to be thrown from any float or moving vehicle. Entrants can hand candy out, but none can be thrown.

### **AGREEMENT TO INDEMNIFY:**

I, the undersigned applicant, desire entry into the Othello Fair and Rodeo Parade and am fully aware that there are special dangers and risks inherent in this activity, including, but not limited to, the risk of serious physical injury, death or other harmful consequences that may arise or result directly or indirectly to the company, group or organization listed above or as a private individual entry from participation in this activity. Being fully informed as to these risks and in consideration of being allowed to participate in Othello Fair and Rodeo sponsored activities, I/we hereby assume all risk of injury, damage and harm to any participant arising from such activities or use. I/we also hereby individually and on behalf of my/our heirs, executors and assigns, release, indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Othello Fair and Rodeo, its officials, employees, volunteers, agents, and the City of Othello, and waive any right of recovery that I/we might have to bring a claim or a lawsuit against the Othello Fair and Rodeo organization and the City of Othello for any personal injury, Othello Fair and Rodeo Parade death or other consequences occurring out of my/our voluntary participation in this activity. This agreement is executed by the authorized representative of the respective organization and shall serve to bind all persons associated with the parade unit. Failure to adhere to this agreement, the Parade Rules and Regulations, or the direction of parade personnel may result in immediate and/or future removal from the Othello Fair and Parade. I, the undersigned, acknowledge receipt of and compliance with Application Instructions, Rules and Regulations, and the above agreement.
